On behalf of our family and our board of directors we send you our profound thanks for standing with us in 2020/2021!!!




Moral

We share *good news* with the coming generation.



- 4 Continue to strengthen and local churches as invited for training, coaching, consulting, and speaking. I will continue coaching pastors and church planters as well as speaking in university contexts. (I'm specifically encouraged to be speaking at Kayla's University in November!)

We hope and pray that you found this report from the field an encouragement to your faith. We pray it stoked the embers for your fires of hope in Jesus, and moves you forward to love and serve others, allowing to God to use you in his work.
