

OUR FLOW AT THE UNDERGROUND

At the Gospel Underground, we have a set of five principles that we call *Guiding Philosophies* that help shape the flow and culture of our service to others.

- 1 Thoughtful and Respectful Engagement
- 2 Underground, Behind the Scenes Ministry
- 3 Rooting and Establishing
- 4 Mentoring and Coaching
- 5 The Primacy of Families and the Local Church

The second philosophy, *Underground, Behind the Scenes Ministry*, has this elaboration on our website:

We do not desire to be center stage in life and mission, but to serve in a joyful, intentional, behind-the-scenes fashion. If we can be the most impactful and influential people that few have ever heard about, we will be grateful for that post in the Kingdom. (John 3:30; Philippians 2:1-11)

We take this very seriously, but it brings a quandary to the forefront. How can you let others know about your work without engaging in self promotion? How do you do marketing and advertising if you would prefer to stay in the background? What if you think you have something decent to offer others? Are we content to allow

the Lord to bring interest to us? Or do we put ourselves forward in certain circles more? Over the last six years I have chosen the path to organically influence in places where the Lord leads. I'm grateful that over the last six years God has given us plenty of work to do. This year has been no exception. I hope in this year's annual report you will see that your investment in our work is bearing fruit in many lives, and in several different circles of influence. The Gospel Underground is dedicated to advancing the mission of God in the borderlands between the church and culture. We do not exist to make our ministry great, but to assist others in accomplishing all that God has given them to do. We thank you for valuing this sort of vision. Your donations and investments allow us to do the work in front of us with our primary concern not being the selling of things or charging high fees for our services. Thank you.

We describe our mission as being accomplished through three lanes: 1) Supporting and strengthening local churches, 2) Sharing the gospel with the coming generation, and 3) Helping the church thoughtfully engage our cultural moment. We have structured this report through these three lenses.



1 SUPPORTING AND STRENGTHENING THE LOCAL CHURCH

This year there have been several opportunities we have assumed that have allowed us to serve the local church. In my own local church, Valley Bible Church, I helped lead a group of twelve or so men pouring into them as leaders for the kingdom. Furthermore, I have been actively coaching three pastors in very different contexts in our country. One is in Austin, TX at the beginning of a church planting journey. Another is leading a church on the New Jersey shore out of the pandemic and into health and future community influence. Yet another is part of a network of churches in Boston metro, serving as an outpost of the love and light of Christ in a New England city. Perhaps the most significant work in strengthening the church I have engaged with this year has been serving as a residency consultant for the Harbor Network.

Harbor Network is a group of churches dedicated to launching, leading, and multiplying healthy churches in North America. In January, I began working with Ed Marcelle, the Harbor director of church planting and multiplication. Ed and I served together in church planting in the northeastern United States when Ed was the northeast regional director for Acts 29. This year Ed asked me to come in and help build residency training for church planters that can be implemented around the country. We are working to create a clear and helpful framework for churches to train future church planters for the work of gospel multiplication. We imagine young men being trained for two years, laying a foundation for fruitful church planting as they launch out in new works. We have designed a residency that's flexible to be implemented in different contexts, regional in that multiple churches can work together providing training, and collaborative in that multiple pastors can instruct the coming generation together. This work involves a combination of curriculum development, program, design, clarity, and training others for effective implementation. It's been right in my wheelhouse, and I thank God for this partnership.

GU ACCESS AND GU PREPARE



We have an exciting new opportunity we are offering to others that launched just this summer. We have written and developed a 10-module leader development curriculum that can be used in local churches. It's designed to create a cohort of men for a one-year intentional development pathway to help them be better friends, husbands, fathers, and church leaders. We have decided to distribute this through a website membership plan that will give access to this curriculum, as well as future tools that we develop. Membership is just \$50 per year

and gives access to *The Gospel Underground Prepare* curriculum, several church planting white papers, special video and audio content, as well as a future curriculum for men and women we are calling *Gospel Underground Deepen*.

Deepen will focus on an introduction to theology and the Bible as well as various ethical issues of our time. We hope to see that launched by Summer 2023. Please let your church leaders know about these resources as we are proud of the way they've turned out. We think they would be helpful to many!





Financial Notes

Income

- This was the first year since 2016 that we did not have a major consulting contract in place for a substantial portion of the year.
- Our year-end matching campaign has remained a vital strategy for funding our work.

Expenses

- This year our board of directors decided to increase matching contributions to the Monaghans 403b which added to our benefits cost.
- GU Prepare development and design costs were invested this fiscal year.
- Travel costs were up significantly this year due to economic conditions.
- This year we made investments in technology and hardware studio expenses with a new laptop and audio/podcast recording equipment.

LOOKING AHEAD

In the coming 12 months we believe the Lord is leading us to focus our time and energy along the following lines:

Support and Strengthen Local Churches

- Beta test and write Harbor residency modules and teach residents locally with Bonhoeffer Haus/Harbor residency
- Equip and help three to four beta sites roll out the residency we design this year
- See GU Access and Prepare get to 48 pastors/churches
- Write a draft for the 10 module GU Deepen curriculum, a theological/biblical/ethics curriculum for training men and women in local church cohorts

Share the Gospel with the coming generation

- Continue as a volunteer for VT Wrestling as the Team Chaplain
- Work through *Prodigal God* and *Counterfeit Gods* by Tim Keller in wrestling Bible study
- Develop two to three young men as leaders and see at least three freshmen involved
- Continue our partnership at Brown University and other invitations
